The candidate should have the following characteristics:

- 1 Choral direction experience.
- 2 Degree in music or comparable work experience.
- 3 Passion for teaching music.
- 4 Knowledge and experience in vocal technique.
- 5 Interest and experience in broad range of musical styles.
- 6 Capable of establishing positive relationships and working with people of varied musical backgrounds and experiences, and integrating them into the group.
- 7 Knowledge of the choral repertoire suitable to various levels, from beginner to experienced singer.
- 8 Capable of working independently, but in cooperation with an accompanist, the music committee and the minister.
- 9 Ability to communicate effectively.
- 10 Some familiarity with Unitarian Universalism.

**Primary Duties:**

- 1 Directing the choir during Sunday services twice a month over a ten-month period (rehearsals beginning in late August, last performance in late June).
- 2 Directing the choir for additional services and functions when mutually agreeable. These may include holiday performances, memorial services, weddings, choir exchanges or other events.
3. Conducting choir rehearsals. The time, day and length of rehearsals will be determined by mutual agreement between choir members and the director.
4. Maintaining the choral music library, purchasing new selections as appropriate.

The available annual salary for the Choir Director is \$3000-\$3500 depending on experience. The Fellowship has a separate budget available for membership in the Unitarian Universalist Musicians Network. Special occasions will be paid on a per diem basis. The tentative starting date is August 18, 2010.
